### V Clean, Safe, Vibrant Streets

- Weekly "Clean & Care Days" led by volunteers.
- Nighttime lighting, park patrols, and positive community presence—not just policing.

#### Community Sharing Economy

- Tool libraries, shared vehicles, food fridges, seed swaps.
- Launch a Neighbourhood Time Bank (1 hour of help = 1 hour of credit).

### 4. 😓 CHILDREN AND YOUTH

- Bring schools into parks and gardens.
- Teach emotional intelligence, cooperation, and real-life skills.
- Create Youth-Led Projects Fund (non-monetary support for projects that inspire).
- Make Loyola a global model for *child-first, nature-connected, purpose-driven education*.

- Partner with residents to provide homes and sanctuaries for stray animals.
- No-kill principles embedded in municipal bylaws.
- Expand green corridors for wildlife.
- Community gardens in every zone.

- Introduce a One World, One Language initiative: English taught as a unifier—not an eraser.
- Bilingualism remains respected, but with English as our global bridge.
- Host cultural and linguistic festivals promoting love, not separation.
